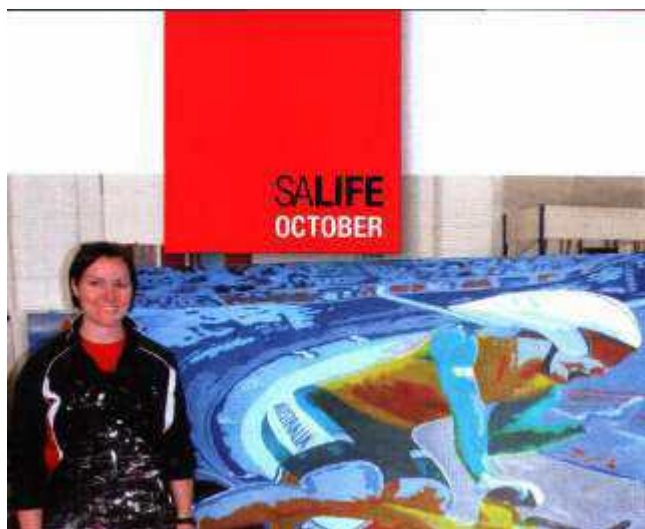

#### Artistic outlet

Olympic cyclist Anna Meares switched from pedalling to painting recently – and her artwork will be auctioned at the Little Heroes Foundation's *Inspiration* art exhibition on Sunday, October 10, from 2pm. It raises money for the Little Heroes Foundation (formerly the McGuinness McDermott Foundation) *Survivorship* program, which helps reduce the impact of cancer and its treatment on children and their families. One service is an art therapy course. The exhibition will also feature works by 20 children aged between two and 11 who paint at Glenelg art school, The Sea House. The children spent between two hours and two weeks perfecting their work, while Anna spent 17 hours painting her interpretation of her gold medal win at the 2004 Olympic Games, before flying to India to compete at the Commonwealth Games. *Inspirations* is at The Sea House, 1-5 Sussex Street, Glenelg. The paintings will be sold through silent auction.
